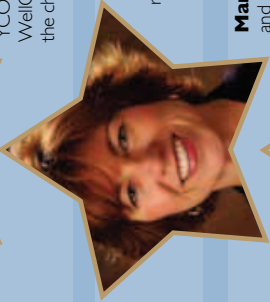
## The Stars Of The Month
